First Steps on Ice



Late Start

Began skating at age 15, unusually late for future champions



Family Influence

His father introduced him to skating, joining him on early ice sessions

Trained under Nina Lepninskaya and Maya Belenkaya

Pair Skating Specialist

Focused on the demanding discipline of pair skating throughout his athletic career

Legendary Partnership

Skated with Tamara Moskvina, who later became a renowned coach herself

Earned silver at 1969 World Championships and claimed Soviet national titles

Guided Urmanov to Olympic gold at the 1994 Lillehammer Games. The victory established Mishin as a premier Olympic-level coach.

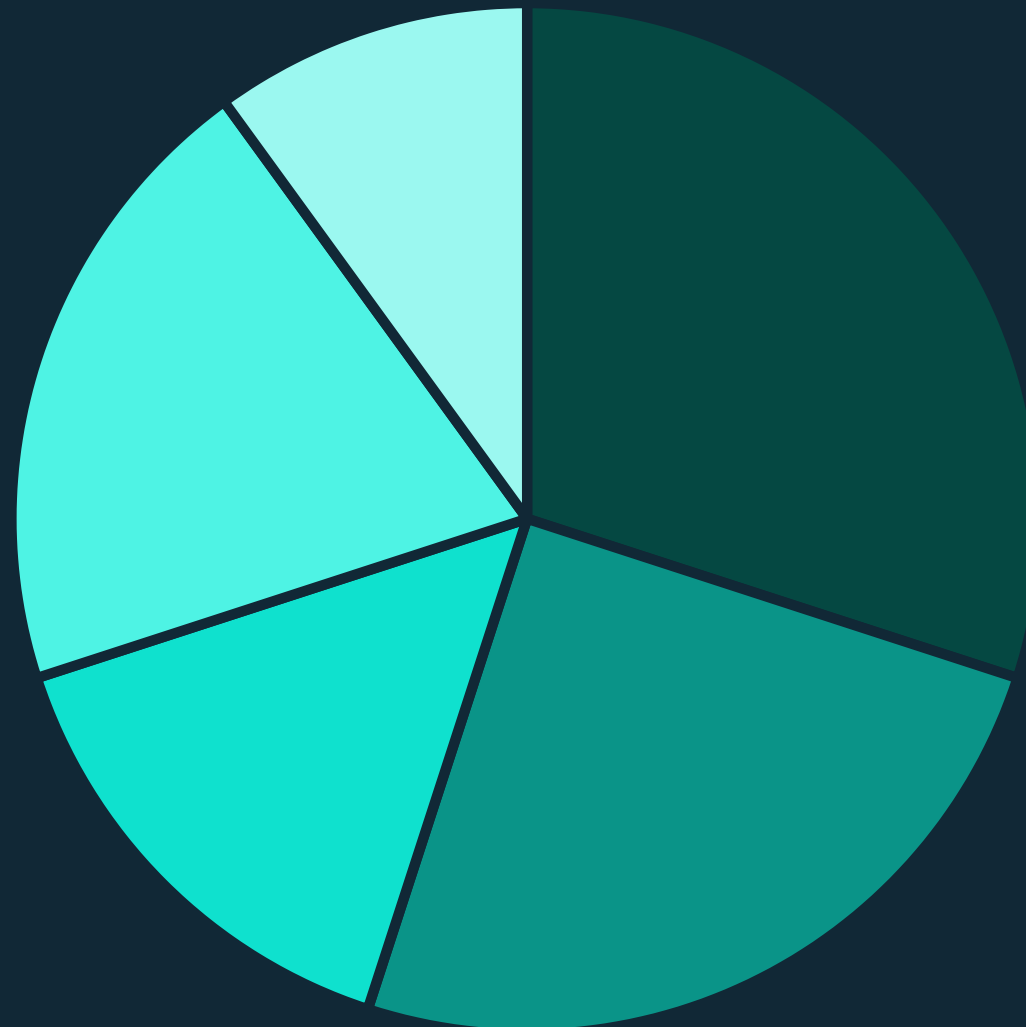
