Tatiana Anatolyevna Tarasova was born into sporting greatness. Her father, Anatoly Tarasov, was the legendary hockey coach who built the Soviet Union's dominant national team.

# The Tarasov Method on Ice

## Technical Precision

Every jump, spin, and step executed with mathematical precision and artistic purpose

## Emotional Expression

Skating must touch hearts, not just impress judges—every program tells a story

## Mental Fortitude

Champions are forged through pressure, discipline, and unwavering self-belief

Inheriting her father's innovative spirit, Tatiana revolutionized figure skating by insisting that technical mastery and artistic expression were inseparable. This philosophy would produce generations of champions.

# Building Champions Daily

Tarasova's training regimen was legendary in its intensity and completeness. Six-hour daily sessions combined technical drills, ballet training, and psychological preparation.

- 4:30 AM ice sessions for technical work
- Ballet classes for artistic development
- Video analysis and mental conditioning
- Music interpretation workshops



Her athletes didn't just learn to skate—they learned to perform with the soul of an artist and the precision of a surgeon.

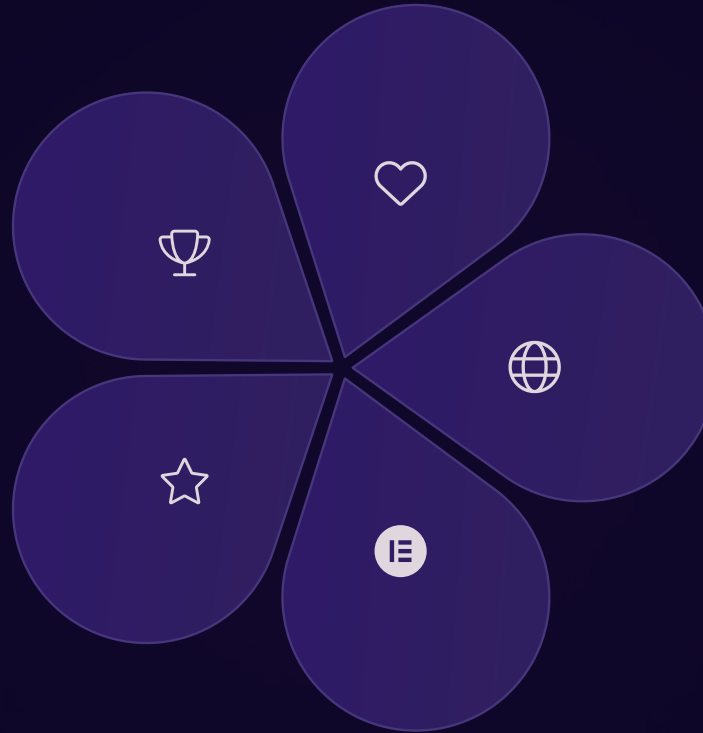
